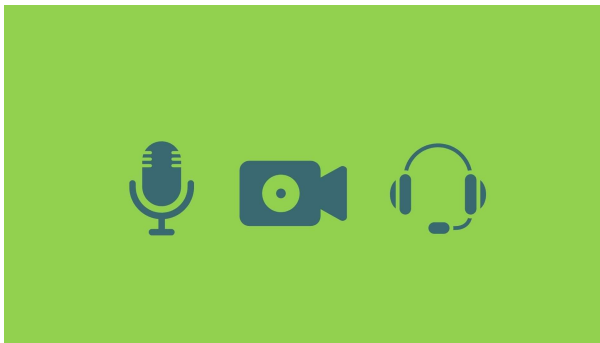

Why small-scale projects?

- Easier entry for the new regions
- Attract new partners
- Address new objectives
- Allow new ideas to take off quickly

Parameters

- Max. 18 months project lifetime
- 3-7 partners (from 3 NSR countries)
- Max. 500.000 Eur total budget (recommended min. 200.000 Eur)
- Use of 40% flat rate



Benefits

- Simpler application
 - shorter application form
 - only one work package
 - easy budget planning



Benefits

- Shorter selection process
- one-step selection procedure
- one single application form
- approx. 4-6 months*
**from submission to decision*

Benefits

- Lighter project setup
- one work package only
- less partners”=”easier coordination
- less complexity

Benefits

- Easier reporting
 - one midterm and one final report
 - very easy validation of expenses
 - 40% flat rate - *example*



Example

A partner's internal staff cost is 100.000 Eur



40% *flate rate** of this staff cost is 40.000 Eur



This amount covers ALL other costs of that partner



Total budget of the partner is 140.000 Eur

**Flat rate: No control checks on the 40%!!!*



Similarities to regular projects

- Can apply in all priorities
- 'Stand alone' nature – essential!
- High quality expected



Similarities to regular projects

- Same intervention logic
- Same indicator set
- Communication objective
- Communication activity(ies)



Set the proper target values

Output indicator target value	Relation	Result indicator target value
Pilot actions implemented	➤ =	Solutions taken-up
Strategies, action plans created	➤ =	Strategies, action plans taken-up
<i>Organisations co-operating</i>	➤	Organisations with increased capacity
