Shared and Digital Mobility Hubs



The ShareDiMobiHub project will implement an integral approach with measures to provide space for shared mobility, communication, discourage private car ownership and integration with public transport. The project will:

- 1. Pilot and scale-up shared mobility hubs in the Netherlands, Belgium, Norway and Denmark.
- 2. Digitally integrate hubs into Mobility as a Service for easy acces for the end-user of the services.
- 3. Deliver a platform to promote shared mobility hubs and to pave the way for others to do the same.

Result: a modal shift towards shared mobility hubs in the North Sea Region.

Lead partner: Province of Utrecht. Pilots and upscaling: Capital Region of Denmark, Leuven, Amsterdam, Transport Authority Amsterdam, Rotterdam and Vestfold and Telemark Region. Research: University of Antwerp and University of Applied Sciences Utrecht. Dissemination: Hamburg University of Applied Sciences, Mpact, Autodelen.net and POLIS.
