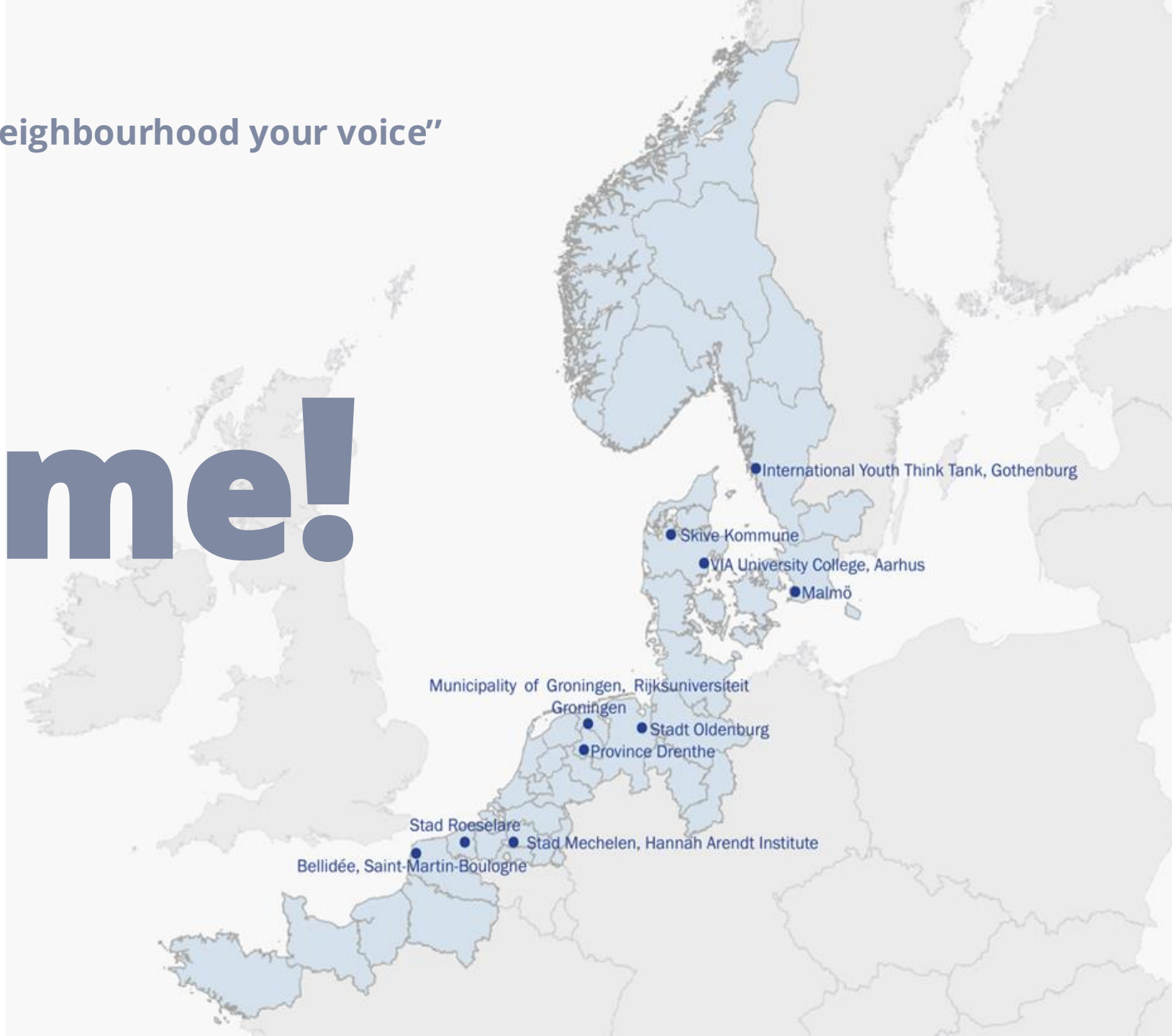

Why Speak Up?

Governments face similar challenges in the great transitions:

- Green transition
 - Digitalisation
 - Background of decreasing trust in government and increasing citizen disengagement
- **We have to develop better ways to strengthen the dialogue between citizen and government, and really give citizens a voice.**

- Hoogkerk is a village next to Groningen
- First Participatory Budget in Groningen
- First edition in 2022
- The municipality guaranteed Hoogkerk that it could organize it at least 10 years

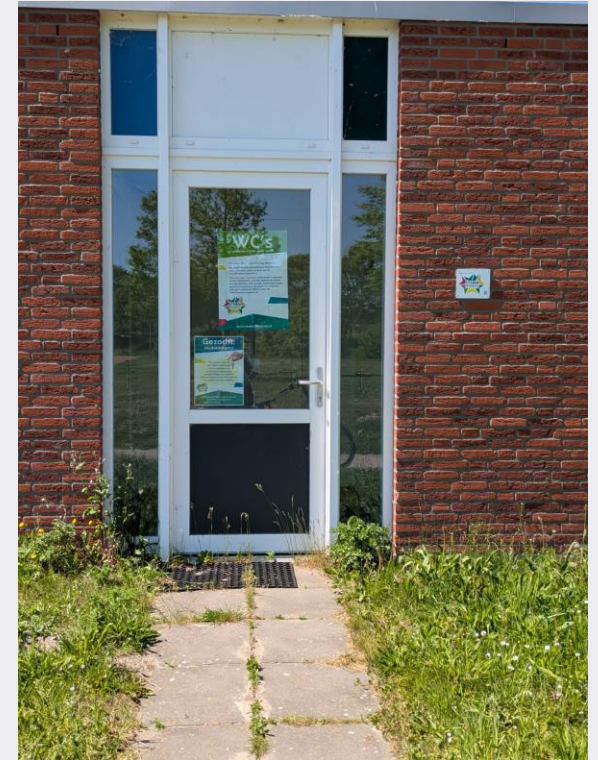

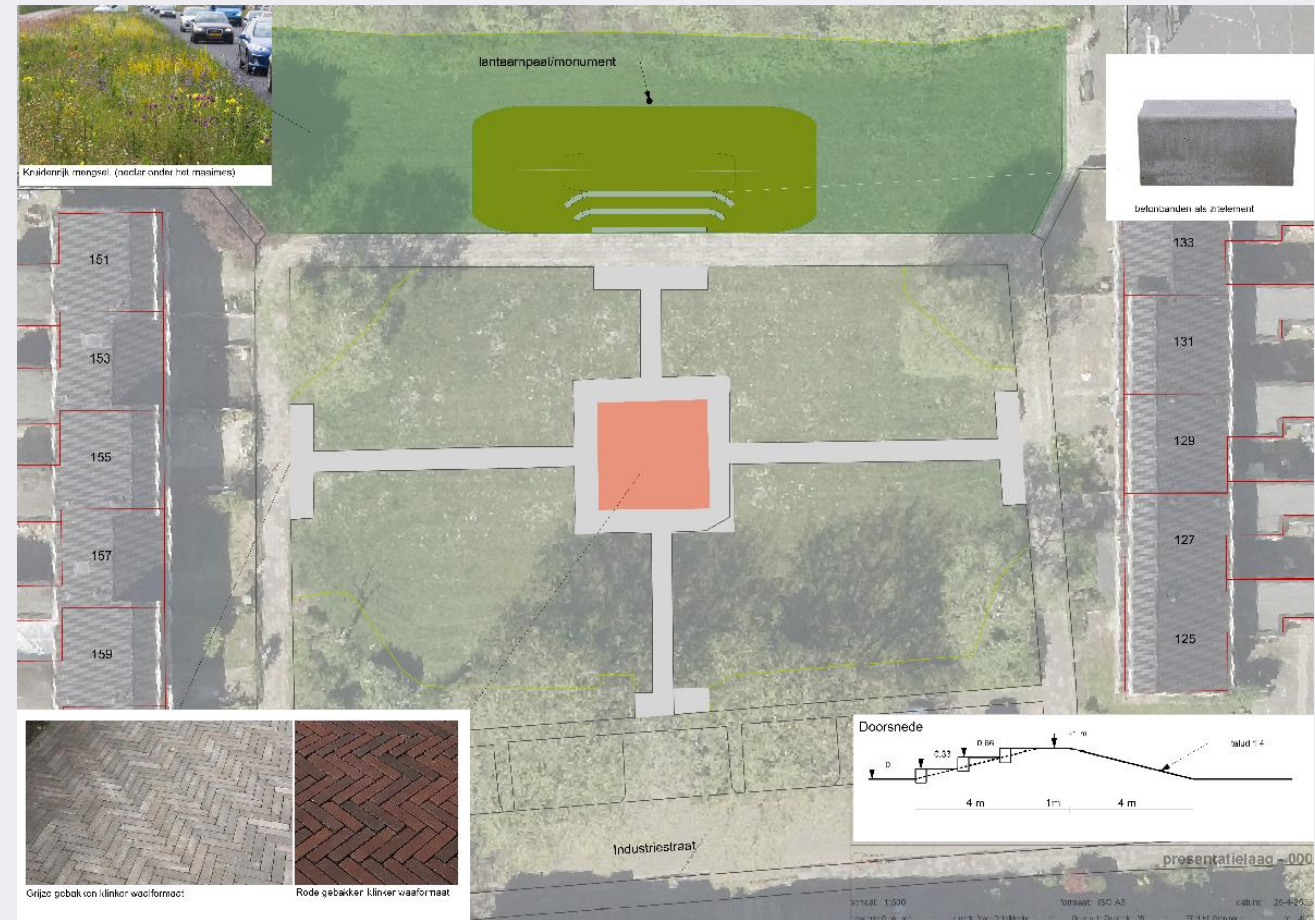

Member of the Moluccan community in Hoogkerk & initiator of 4 selected projects

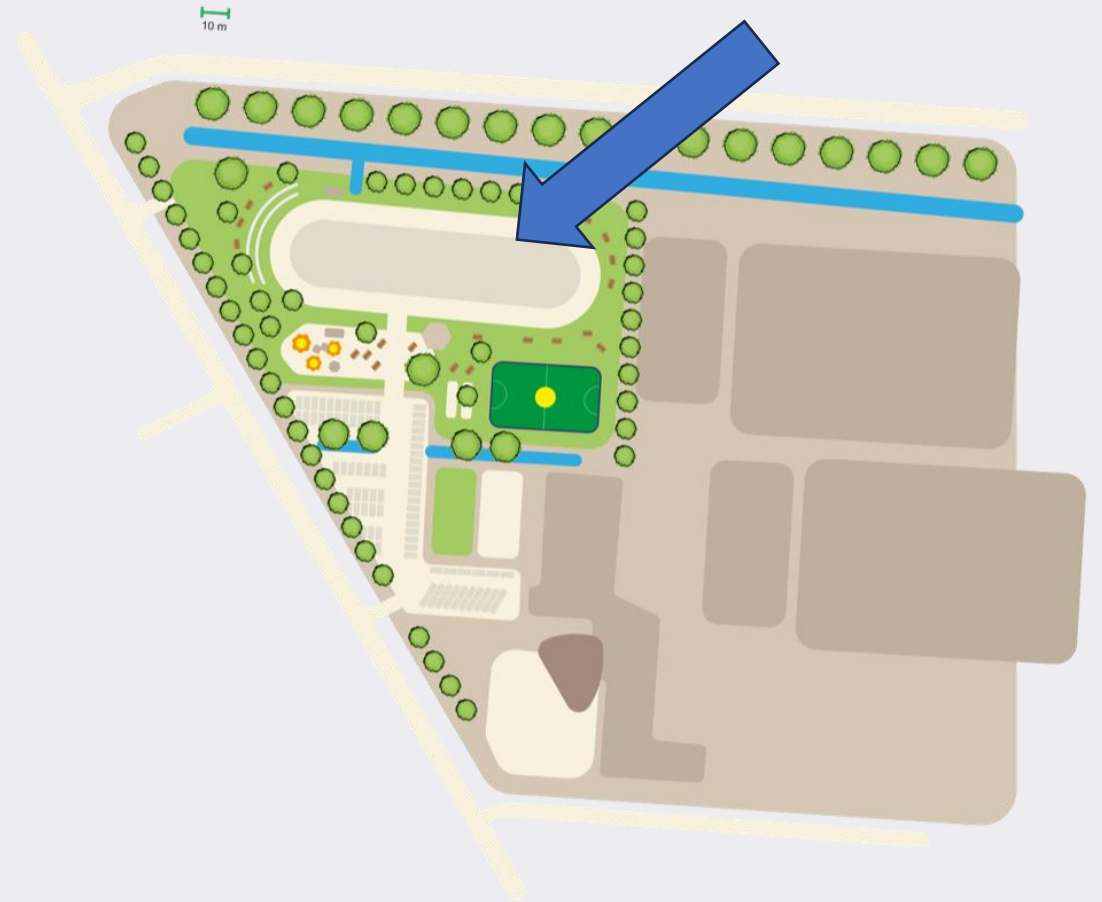


Lessons learned

Big projects can be difficult...

- Big projects can't be constructed in 1 year. Therefore, they have to be split up in smaller projects.
- People have high expectations when they vote on the project, but there is no visible short-term result...
- Big projects can be difficult to manage for citizens as this requires specific skills

Lessons learned

How to attract a representative and diverse group?

- Communication is key
- Do something special
- Organize events for youth and elderly people
- Organize events for parts of Hoogkerk with lower engagement
- Ensure visibility in the neighbourhood
- Not everything works... we are still learning!
