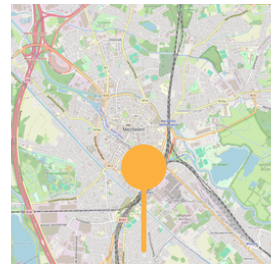
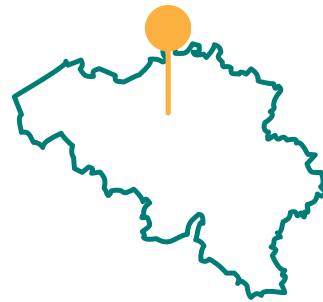

Our Inhabitants

Ghandiwijk is an existing social and mid-segment neighbourhood with 790 social houses and flats for 1787 inhabitants. The site has been remodeled in the context of sustainable urban renewal. It includes a community service centre and a Hoppin mobility hub.



Shared Mobility

Residents will have access to (electric) car-sharing, (electric) bike-sharing, electric scooter-sharing, public transport and affordable mobility solutions for people with a disability. Inhabitants will also have access to high-quality bike parking and nearby parcel lockers.



Mobility Plan

A tailored communication and participation concept for and with the residents will be developed. Personal guidance from a community worker with expertise in shared mobility is foreseen. This facilitates the transition to shared mobility. Reduced tariffs will be introduced as well.
