Challenge

Attracting future ET installers to pursue a career in the energy transition

Lack of comprehensive and flexible learning opportunities for students of a range of skill levels

Lack of diversity in the workforce, particularly in isolated locations like islands

Approach

Enhance recruiting for potential workers through regional campaigns

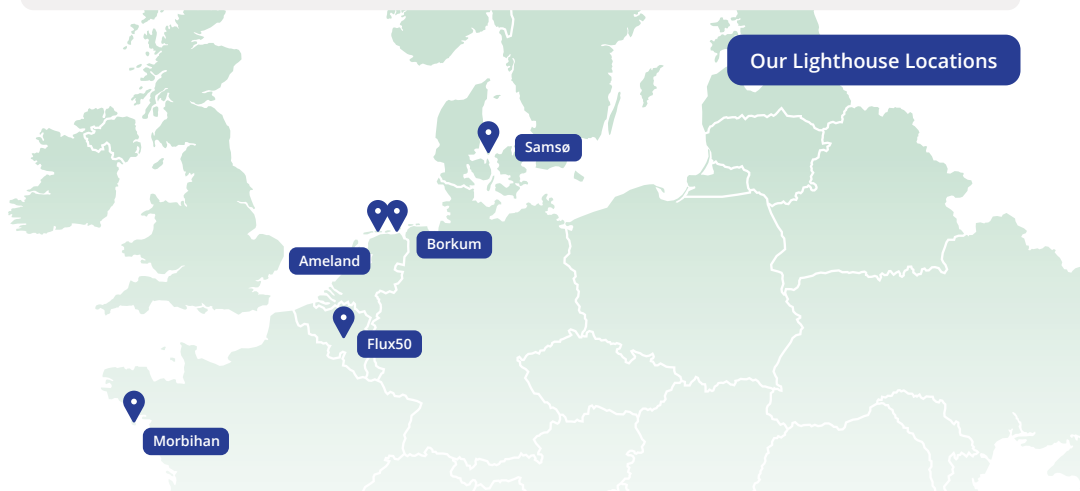
Bottom-up educational program that promotes collaboration between leading ET islands and VET schools

Provide hands on learning opportunities through traineeships on islands and involve local communities

Intended Outcomes

- ✓ Introduction of ET-relevant Short Advanced Courses in VET school.
- ✓ Increased number of students (graduates and career changers) through targeted recruitment campaigns.
- ✓ Accelerated growth in capacity and skills with 1,000 certified ET-graduates & upskilled employees.
- ✓ Structured exchange of best practices in ET learning among North Sea regions.
- ✓ Proactive contribution to national and EU policies on urgent ET technical education.
