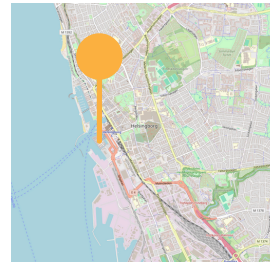
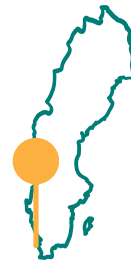

Our inhabitants

Oceanhamnen currently consists of four residential blocks with 340 homes, three office buildings, and 32,000 m² of business and services. Phase two is under development and will host our Living Lab: here, we will inspire inhabitants about alternatives to privately-owned cars.



Shared Mobility

The residents in Oceanhamnen already have access to shared cars, electric city bikes, and e-scooters. They can also make use of the newly constructed bridge for pedestrians and cyclists, which connects Oceanhamnen with Helsingborg Central Station.



Mobility Plan

Helsingborg is expanding the shared mobility offer. Current and future users will have access to an application that shows all services and allows them to be booked on the spot. Furthermore, a city-wide parking guidance app allows making more efficient use of parking spaces.

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
